BPFMS regularly hosts **local discussions** on current matters (**roundtables**) which are open for colleagues in science and non-academic practice to join!

The initiative's core team is also involved in discussions with international and strategic partners, e.g. at the **5th Conference of the German Network for Migration Studies** in 2024, or during the **International Days 2023** at the University of Bonn.

The initiative's member bicc is doing pioneering work in refugee policy by establishing a **Refugee Advisory Board for Germany** in cooperation with the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), the Federal Foreign Office and the Robert Bosch Foundation. The **national secretariat** will be hosted by bicc.
